Watch for these posters in your communities!

Feeding South Dakota administers the Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP). We get food products from the USDA and pack the food in boxes, seal them, then ship them to sites in 2/3's of the



state. Persons 60 and over fill out an application and then are certified if they meet an income level. Once certi-

fied, each month they get the CSFP box. This can provide our seniors with over 31# of great food PLUS the cheese!

This is what is in the box this month: Corn Flakes, Bran Flakes, Grape Juice, Orange Juice, Canned Beef, Peanut Butter, Evaporated Milk, corn Spinach, Applesauce, Mixed vegetables, Peaches, Sweet Peas, Dry Milk, Rice (these are all non perishable products) PLUS the cheese.

Please encourage all seniors 60 and over whose household income is (130% above poverty level, gross income for a 1 person household is

\$1174 per month), to apply for this program.



A long time coming....

There are so many people to thank for the expansion of Feeding South Dakota into Pierre! If it weren't for the tenacity of the Pierre residents to solve the problem of wasted food, this project would have never come to fruition. The Food Bank is now 100% complete with the recent installation of the cooler and freezer. The racking is in place and gradually being filled with donated food on a daily basis. On June 22nd, our truck made the first pick-up of donated food from Wal-mart.

What type of program is your organization and how many do you serve?

The Banquet is a feeding ministry. A safe place where anyone can come for a meal and fellowship. Volunteers prepare and serve 9 meals a week to the guests. When you serve a meal here you also eat with the guests and that is an experience that most volunteers find is the best thing about being at The Banquet. We serve on average of 200 at breakfast, 400 at supper and 350 for Saturday lunch. We find that anywhere from 10-20% of our count are children, 12 and younger. Last year we served a total of 148,258 meals. This year we have served 66,480 meals with 8689 of those meals being served to children.

How do you utilize Feeding South Dakota?

We use the food bank to help stretch the food dollars that we have to spend on the meals.
